

Two entries will be accepted in respect of each car. CREW must keep their feet on the cockpit Floor within the confines of the car. Standing is not allowed. No competition car may be driven On any part of the course or adjoining lands by any person other than a person who entered the Event and who has signed the Official Entry Form. Breach of this Regulation may merit exclusion. A Bouncer or Passenger may be carried subject to Motorsport Ireland Regulations. See Year Book for details. Drivers must advise the Clerk of the Course when they retire. Unsporting behaviour may merit exclusion from results. Abuse and/or intimidation of any official or observer of the event will merit exclusion from the event and will be reported to M.I for action by them.

All Competitors must be in possession of a current M.I Competition Licence to be produced on demand. No Competitor may receive assistance, advice or direction from any

outsider whilst traversing any section.

Competition Licences

A Clubman National B (or higher grade Licence) is available to competitors over 16 years.

Competitors other than Junior Licence Holders must hold such a Licence.

Purpose – Motorsport Ireland (M.I.) have created this policy document to ensure that any individual involved in any form of motorsport in Ireland, which is governed by M.I., understand and agree to their responsibilities when using social media and in particular when posting content to any form of social media or to any Internet websites, blogs, forums or message boards

The Competitor / Official named hereunder hereby, by signing this document, agree and understand as follow:

- 1- This policy document covers all those involved within the sport whether they are a Competitor. Entrant, Parent of a Competitor or Entrant, Team Official or Motorsport Ireland Official whilst participating under Motorsport Ireland regulations regardless of their original national ASN. This policy is referred to in the entry forms for all events is binding upon Competitors from other national ASNs in that manner
- 2- Any content submitted online through the medium of the Internet by those participating or officiating at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events should not contain material that could be deemed to be threatening, harassing, bullying,

- illegal, obscene, defamatory, slanderous or hostile towards any individual team or entity participating or officiating at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events or the Governing Body, Motorsport Ireland
- 3- Content is defined as text, images, audio, video and any user generated content knowingly uploaded to the Internet
- 4- Furthermore it is the responsibility of those who participate or officiate at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events to make sure that any third party associated with them, does not submit content online which would be in breach of this policy. If a third party submits such content which is clearly associated with the participant or official, it is the participant or official who will be held responsible by Motorsport Ireland for the breach of this policy. In this regard the onus is on the participant or official to prove that the third party is not in any way associated with them.
- 5- All those who participator officiate at Motorsport Ireland sanctioned events are reminded that the General Competition Rules, as defined within the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook and/or Motorsport Ireland website, apply at all times and that failure to adhere to the policies set out in this document will result in a breach of those regulations and the penalties and sanctions as set out in the current Yearbook and/or website will apply
